- **Recycling** is picked up by the Town of Newmarket on most **Monday mornings**. If at all possible please leave your bins out early on Monday morning. Leave your bin of recyclables at the end of the driveway or in designated area if you live on Eagle Drive or end Cushing/Osprey Lane. The bins may be purchased at Town Hall. - Larger items to be recycled, such as cardboard boxes, may be broken down and left in small easily handled bundles on Mondays or may be taken to the **town transfer station** on Ash Swamp Road. Directions are in your welcome book. This station is open only on Saturdays. Please, **NEVER put cardboard or large household items in the dumpsters**.
- The dumpsters are to be used **ONLY** for small/daily-type household trash. All trash should be in plastic bags and should not be anything of a large size such as a lamp, old furniture, filing cabinets, etc.
- If you have a dog, please be aware that **all dogs must be walked on a leash. When you walk your dogs it is imperative that you pick up after them!**
- Please be aware that most of the land closest to the water is **MPCA owned, Lot 4**. This property is environmentally sensitive. The NH Department of Environmental Services (DES) has lots of strict guidelines on trespassing and trimming in these areas. If you stick to the pathways and don't use your clippers you will be fine. Additional information is available under "Environment" on the website.
- Our **screen house** has its own set of guidelines. These are on the website under "Community Life" "Notices". Keep your eyes out for many Moody Point activities during the year. All events should appear on your email, the web, under "Community Life" and on the Bulletin Board near the dumpsters.
